ZION: January Giving is over budget by \$17,256. Expenses are over budget by \$1,996. January ended with a Net Gain of \$14,723. YTD Net Income Loss is \$6,752, under budget by \$7,231. YTD Giving is down by \$6,696.

FRIENDS OF JESUS PRESCHOOL: Income is under budget by \$4,640. Expenses are under budget by \$4,562. January Net Loss is \$60. YTD Net Income Gain is \$2,106, over budget by \$8,718.
