<u>COVID NOTIFICATION:</u> We continue to monitor COVID activity and are abiding by guidance of our local health department and CDC. Masked or unmasked, you are welcome here.

One of our members who attended 8am Sunday worship, Oct 3<sup>rd</sup>, and is fully vaccinated, tested positive for COVID on Monday. The person has mild symptoms, and has spoken to everyone they have been in close contact with. We are being as careful as we can. Should anyone else who was here test positive, please let people you have had close contact with know.

The Kalamazoo County Health department's guidance is that if you have had close contact (within 6ft for at least 15 minutes) with someone who tests positive you should monitor yourself for 10 days. Fully vaccinated people are not required to self-quarantine. If you have symptoms or are concerned, get tested. These are interesting and confusing times but as long as we are sensitive to the present realities and open with questions and concerns, we are being responsible in our care for each other.
